Description: The CERT TtT course prepares participants to teach the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) course to volunteers in their communities at classes sponsored by their local jurisdiction. Course content, instructional methodology and administrative considerations for implementing the program are covered. Participants must be sponsored by their local jurisdiction and have completed CERT basic training. Course prerequisites will not be waived.

Prerequisites: Refer to the pre-requisite checklist/application to ensure that you are eligible to attend the course.

Target Audience: Local and County Emergency Management, Fire, Law Enforcement, and EMS personnel.
