Fact Sheet for Equipment Marking

June 1, 2013

As outlined in the subgrantee agreement, the subgrantee agrees that when practicable, any equipment purchased with Federal Homeland Security grant funding shall be prominently marked as follows: **"Purchased with funds provided by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security."** Please mark all qualifying equipment as indicated.

A minimum of a 2-inch x 2-inch or 1-inch x 3-inch sticker/label/markings is **required** for the following categories of equipment:

- Computer equipment
- Large media displays (including websites and advertisements)
- Robots
- Detection/sensor equipment/cases
- Optics equipment/cases
- Training aids
- SCBA equipment/cases
- Medical equipment/cases (non-pharmaceuticals/non-disposable)

A minimum of a 3-inch x 6-inch sticker/label/markings is **required** for the following categories of equipment:

- All Vehicles
- Trailers
- Generators
- Communications towers and structures

The following categories of equipment or equipment used in the examples below do not require marking; however, if the piece of equipment is stored in a case, the equipment case should be marked.

- Any equipment in which the marking labels would be worn off/destroyed through routine use
- Equipment that is designed for use within a hazardous material environment and the act of decontamination on the piece(s) of equipment would remove the label.
- Portable communications equipment (such as phones and radios)
- Search and rescue equipment (Ex.: climbing or shoring equipment)
- Decontamination equipment
- PPE
- Hand tools
- Medical pharmaceuticals and disposable equipment
