

EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT SCAVENGER HUNT

Introduction:

How prepared is your family? Go on a scavenger hunt to find the recommended supplies that are listed below to help your family prepare. Print this list out to begin the scavenger hunt. Once you find an item, place it in a large plastic container to start building your family's emergency supply kit. Together we can help make Arizona's family better prepared for an emergency or natural disaster.

Emergency Supplies:

Water, food, and clean air are the important things to have if an emergency happens. Each family or individual's kit should be customized to meet specific needs, such as medications and infant formula. It should also be customized to include important family documents.

Recommended Supplies to Include in a Basic Kit:

- Water, one gallon of water per person per day, for drinking and sanitation
- Food, at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food
- Battery-powered radio and extra batteries
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- First Aid kit
- Whistle to signal for help
- Infant formula and diapers, if you have an infant
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- Toiletries
- Dust mask or cotton t-shirt, to help filter the air
- Plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- Can opener for food
- Medications (Have adult supervision)

Clothing and Bedding:

It is possible that the power will be out and you will not have heating or air conditioning. One complete change of clothing and shoes per person, including:

- A jacket or coat (if winter time)
- Pants
- A shirt
- Sturdy shoes
- A hat to protect you from the sunlight
- A sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person

Additional Items:

Below are some other items for your family to consider adding to its supply kit. Some of these items can be dangerous, so please have an adult collect these supplies listed with a notation for parental involvement.

- Mess kits, paper cups, plates and plastic utensils
- Paper towels
- Fire Extinguisher (Have adult supervision)
- Tent
- Compass
- Paper, pencil
- Personal hygiene items
- Family Documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a waterproof, portable container. **(Get your Parents to help you with this part of the scavenger hunt)**
